

**ARTICLE XXII**

**REINSTATEMENT OF  
MEMBERS**

Sec. 1. Any member suspended for being in arrears for three (3) months, but less than six (6) months, may apply for reinstatement.

Sec. 2. Any member in arrears, if eligible for reinstatement, shall pay his L.U. all arrearages and assessments, and

reinstatement fees. "A" members shall pay a reinstatement fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) and "BA" members shall pay a reinstatement fee of three dollars (\$3.00). Half of all such fees are to be sent to the I.S.T. In addition, all "A" members shall pay a pension reinstatement fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00), all of which shall be forwarded to the I.S.T. for the Pension Benefit Fund. Reinstated members shall retain their former card number. Any reinstated applicant shall be subject to the limitations imposed by this Constitution.

Sec. 3. A reinstated member shall not be entitled to any L.U. benefits until six (6) months after reinstatement.

Sec. 4. Reinstated members' standing in the I.O. shall be the same as that of new members except as provided in Section 5 of this Article.

Sec. 5. For pension purposes only, an "A" member suspended because of an arrearage in his dues who is reinstated pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution, shall be restored to the continuous good standing he enjoyed prior to his suspension.
