Sears has locked out their service technicians in the Lower Mainland of British Columbia

- We are the people who repair your Sears' appliances.
- We are skilled technicians who can repair anything from your furnace, television, exercise equipment and/or your lawn mower.
- We are negotiating revisions to our collective agreement with Sears.
- On October 1st, 2007, we were locked out by Sears because we would not work under a collective agreement they imposed. The imposed document contains many concessions, including four years without negotiated wage increases, split work weeks, loss of Boxing Day as a paid holiday, working two and one-half hours a week in excess of the regular work week with no overtime.
- In our opinion, this is an attempt by Sears at union busting.
- Many of us have families and are long-term employees.
- We are united and we will see this through until we get a fair contract.
